1633

Daughters of Charity were formed in France, devoting themselves to serving the poor.

1909

Bishop James Michael Curley of St. Augustine asked the daughters for help in Jacksonville.



1898

The Daughters of Charity came to the new world and 32 of them served in Jacksonville during the Spanish-American War.

1916

Four sisters moved to Jacksonville and took over the failing DeSoto Sanatorium and renamed the hospital "St. Vincent's" after Saint Vincent de Paul. They served the sickest people in the community and helped the hospital run smoothly again.

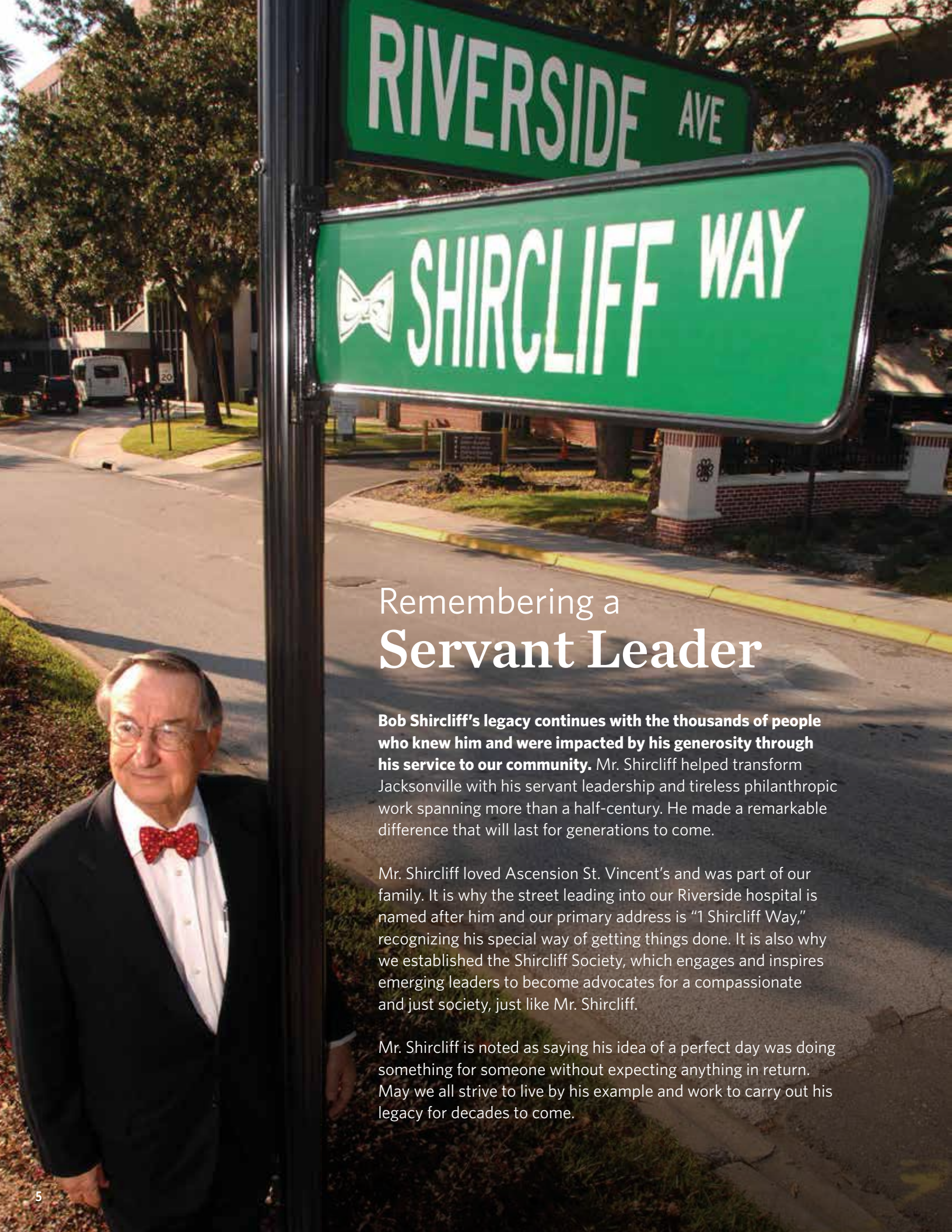

Kids Together Against Cancer (KTAC) offers support to children and their families during a parent's cancer journey. KTAC fosters resilience, hope & bravery in children. KTAC and other cancer support groups serve an average group of **36** participants each month who are currently coping with the impact of cancer.

Medical Mission at Home

Medical Mission at Home delivers free medical care to those with limited access to care and connects them to a medical home for follow up care. We have served over 1,000 participants since 2016.

The Delores Barr Weaver Heart and Vascular Pavilion: Opening in Spring 2020

Delores Barr Weaver's generous naming gift for the Heart Pavilion will be a part of her legacy of love, hope, and healing in the community. She, along with countless other generous donors have made this pavillion possible.

This \$55 million pavilion is 58,000 square feet and includes 30 medical and surgical rooms and 30 intensive care rooms.

Lung Institute

The Ascension St. Vincent's Lung Institute was built in the Betsy Lovett Center and began caring for patients last year, thanks to a generous gift from Betsy Lovett.

- Largest pulmonary practice in Northeast Florida
- Lung cancer is the leading cause of cancer death
- Pulmonologists tracked 2,276 patients with at-risk lung nodules identified on low dose CT screenings
- The Veran Electromagnetic Navigation Bronchoscopy increases accuracy of biopsies by 50%, which allows for earlier detection and treatment

The St. Pius Primary Care Clinic

The St. Pius Primary Care Clinic partners with St. Pius V Catholic Church to serve the vulnerable population in Jacksonville's Health Zone 1. St. Pius provides important medical services which are integrated into the church ministry. Dental X-Ray

A new digital x-ray sensor for the Mobile Health Dental Unit was funded through a grant from the Florida Association of Free and Charitable Clinics that allows us to serve more people.

- Last year, this unit made possible more than 2,000 x-rays

3D Mobile Mammography

Ascension St. Vincent's Mobile Mammography has provided more than 2,000 mammograms each year since 2002.

- In 2019, 3D Digital Mammography with Smart Curve Technology was purchased thanks to gifts from the Rice Family and Mr. and Mrs. Bob Shircliff.
- This new technology improved upon previous mammogram technology
 - 40% increase in invasive cancer detection
 - 20% reduction in false positives
 - 40% less radiation
 - Improves comfort for 93% of mammogram patients
 - Ascension St. Vincent's has made all of these new innovations available by investing \$1 million in a new Mobile Mammography unit which will make this resource accessible throughout the communities who need it the most beginning in 2020.

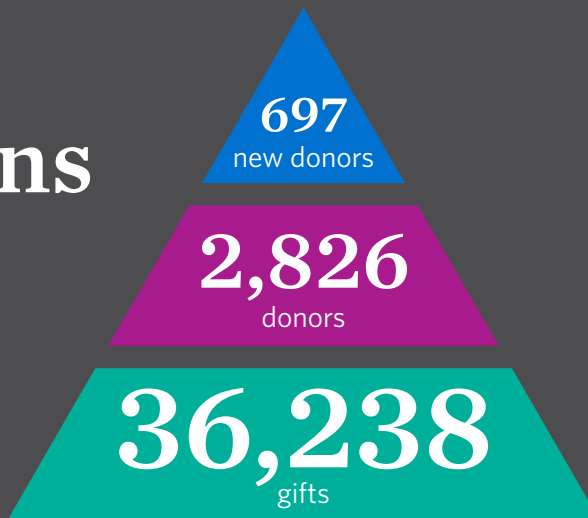

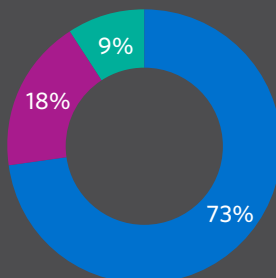

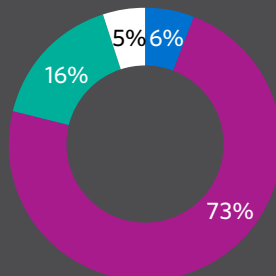
Contributions by Type
